In March, mark your calendar for Tuesday night March 11th, as the Post will have Dogs Inc here to present a donation check for our continued sponsorship of the dog scholarships that help pay for a Veteran and their new dog to get trained together. It is shaping up to be one of our larger donations, so you want to be there to

part of a special presentation. It is also a match period, so what we give will be matched by a corporation to help Dogs Inc with the overall cost of running such an incredible program.

As we have done for several years, the Post will continue our support of Operation Stand Down. While this event honors the service and sacrifice of all Veterans, it places an emphasis on the homeless and at-risk Veterans. During the April 25-26th event Veterans in need can receive dental and medical care, legal assistance, haircuts, housing assistance and spiritual counseling. The Post has made one of our larger donations this year and will be a major sponsor of the Food Court Area. Also, this year, Post 173 Legion Riders are coming on board with an additional large donation to assist with sponsoring the Chaplains Tent at the two-day event. The event will be at The Concourse Rotary Pavillion, Shady Hills, FL just off State Route 52. Our Children and Youth Programs are going well. We just donated some equipment to Gulf Side Elementary so they will have an outside wash station to clean the vegetable they get from the children's garden. We provided a donation to the school to replace a shed they lost during our back-to-back hurricanes, and we are sponsoring several other programs at the school. We are beginning to research other assistance that we can provide to other elementary schools in our area that have children in need of food, school supplies and clothes. As we develop this program, look for the flyers asking for your help with donations. We also continued our support of the Holiday

Rec Center by sponsoring the Spring Basketball League.

The month of April is a big fund-raising effort for the Legion Riders as Statewide they raise awareness and money in support of the American Legion Department of Florida's Project Vet Relief- Suicide Awareness. We have the Rockabilly Band, Jeff Vitolo and the Quarter Mile Rebels, back Saturday night March 29th to kick it off, so watch for the flyers and block out the date, should be a great night working to raise money for an even greater cause!

The spring of the year starts the election cycle for the Post, and its family units. The Post will have nominations for officers on March 13th, April 10th, and May 8th (write-ins), with the elections taking place on May 8th. Our Post only gets stronger and better with more participation. I would encourage you to consider running for a position, but if not, at least come out and vote on your Post leadership.
